#### A Wee Bit of Background

Jude = Judas = Judah

**Brother of Jesus** 

Matthew 13:55 - Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary? And are not his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?

Acts 1:14 – Mary and the brothers of Jesus are with the disciples.

Galatians 1:19 – Jesus' brother James is called an apostle by Paul.

Main theme – warning about false teachers





#### A Wee Bit of Background

- Apostasy An abandonment of what one has professed; a total desertion of, or departure from, one's faith
- Many are led into apostasy by false teachers.
  - Matthew 7:15-20 Jesus warns about false prophets
  - Paul warns about false teachers in every letter except Philemon
  - Peter warns about false teachers in his letters.
