II. Ask, Seek, and Knock

A Little Bit of Greek Grammar Present Active Imperative

Commands that are expected to be followed not once, but as an ongoing process.

Ex. - The doctor tells you, "Eat more vegetables!" He doesn't mean to do it once but as an ongoing process as part of a daily dietary routine.



II. Ask, Seek, and Knock

A Little Bit of Greek Grammar Present Active Imperative

Commands that are expected to be followed not once, but as an ongoing process.

Ask and keep on asking Seek and keep on seeking Knock and keep on knocking

U – Until

S - Something

H - Happens
