

What is an ambassador?

An ambassador is a citizen of a country who represents their country's interests in a foreign country.

The primary role of an ambassador is to establish and maintain diplomatic relations between the two countries, facilitate trade and commerce, and promote cultural and educational exchange programs.

What is an ambassador for Christ?

An ambassador for Christ is a citizen of The Kingdom of God who represents God's interests in the foreign kingdom - The World.

The primary role of an ambassador is to establish and maintain diplomatic relations between the two realms, facilitate interaction, and promote Kingdom priorities and objectives.





What is an ambassador for Christ?

⁹But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. ¹⁰Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

¹¹Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul. ¹²Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation.

Duties of an Ambassador

- 1. Represent the home country
- 2. Build and maintain relationships
- 3. Negotiate agreements
- 4, Provide information and advice
- 5. Protect the interests of their citizens
- 6. Manage embassy staff
- 7. Report back to the home government all things related to your work as an ambassador

Duties of an Ambassador for Christ

- 1. Represent God and His Kingdom

- 7. Report back to God all things related to your work as an ambassador


