

The Examen

St. Ignatius Loyola made the Examen one of the few rules for the Jesuits. He required them to work through The Examen twice daily – at noon and at the end of the day. He gave them five steps for the practice.

- 1. Become aware of God's presence.
 - 2. Review the day with gratitude.
 - 3. Pay attention to your emotions.
- 4. Choose one feature of the day and pray from it.
 - 5. Look toward tomorrow.


