



What you will be given and what you will find and what will be opened to you is found in Luke 11:11-13

"You fathers—if your children ask for a fish, do you give them a snake instead? Or if they ask for an egg, do you give them a scorpion? Of course not! So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him."

Thank God that He doesn't get tired of us asking, seeking, and knocking, but that he is pleased when we do.


Ask God for bold and believing faith that doesn't waver or doubt. Pray, "Lord, I believe. Help my unbelief." (Mark 9:24)
