Tell es-Sultan, the mound on which the city was built rises 70 feet above the surrounding plain.


The Mount of Temptation is about 2 miles from the ruins of Jericho.

Do You Want to Be Safe or Saved? <u>Jericho Destruction Timeline</u>

- c. 8300–7500 BC Neolithic A (Stone Age) abandoned after a few centuries possible earthquake
- c. 4300 BC Neolithic B (Stone Age) settlement regressed & finally deserted
- c. 3400–2100 BC Early Bronze Age destroyed many times military action & earthquakes
- c. 2350 BC End of Early Bronze Age devastated by a terrible widespread fire - complete destruction of double city-walls which were rebuilt
